

At the piazzetta between the National Theatre and New Stage (ex-Laterna Magika) you will find a dwelling of thirty white cubes/black boxes. This architectural maze is inhabited by performative projects by scenographers, performers, choreographers, film directors, drama theatre, installation artists, fashion designers, writers and painters, etc.

It's a live exhibition that will talk to you only if you talk back to it. This living and breathing exhibition will tell you stories, and the more time you spend there the more it will speak to you. It will teach you to dance, and it will ask you to listen. It will require positioning and it will let you get lost. If you are afraid of intimacy — you'd better not enter.

If you continue walking around the streets of Prague you might bump into strange situations, scenographies... these might be the project of the boxes that have spilled out from the boxes and gotten scattered around the public space. Some of them tiny – creating close intimacy in the public space, some of them more 'grandiose' – political, questioning, and irritating. This is what we call spectacular!

But it will all question one and the same thing: what is performance? And who is performing? ("Not I!", said he.) Is theatre something theatrical — an illusion, a straight-forward lie? Or is theatre just one of the basic ways to express ourselves? ...everyday. But if you look very long and extremely carefully you might find things that are not performance, too, that are simply 'a thing in itself'! Probably...


